Non-Local Tourist Guide shot by Terrorists in Shopian

n a grievous act of violence on April 8, a non-local tourist guide was brutally attacked by terrorists in the Shopian district of Jammu and Kashmir. The victim, namely Dilranjan Singh, 45, son of Parman Singh, sustained severe bullet injuries while performing his duties as a guide for two foreign tourists.

The harrowing incident unfolded around 8:25 PM in the serene locality of Hirpora, within Shopian's Padpawan area. Singh, alongside his foreign charges, was partaking in a meal at a local eatery when the tranquility was shattered by a sudden onslaught of gunfire. The armed terrorists, targeted Singh, leaving him with critical injuries to his abdomen and arm. In the aftermath of the attack, Singh was swiftly administered first aid before being referred to the Shri Maharaja Hari Singh (SMHS) Hospital in Srinagar for advanced medical intervention. The two foreign tourists, although physically unscathed, were understandably shaken and have been placed under protective custody by local law enforcement agencies to ensure their safety and well-being.

This egregious act underscores the persistent security challenges in the region, which has been striving to shed its image of conflict and promote tourism. Despite numerous initiatives to bolster tourist safety and revive the local economy, such incidents pose significant setbacks. The safety and security of visitors remain



paramount, and authorities are intensifying the security protocols in response to such incidents.

The local community and business owners have expressed profound sorrow and condemnation over the attack. Many have stressed the importance of peace and stability, which are crucial for the sustenance and growth of the tourism sector. Government officials alongside civil society have also denounced the attack, reaffirming their commitment to safeguarding the region's tourism industry. SCHOOL HEAD-MASTER ARRESTED WITH FOREIGN-MADE PISTOL AND GRENAUES IN POONCH

n a significant operation, Jammu and Kashmir Police, in collaboration with the Special Operations Group (SOG) and the Indian Army's 39 Rashtriya Rifles (RR) of 6 Sector, Romeo Force, apprehended a registered Over Ground Worker (OGW) who is also a school headmaster. The arrest took place in the Hari Budha area of Poonch district. The individual Qamaruddin. was found in possession of a foreign-made pistol and Chinese grenades, raising concerns about the security of the upcoming elections in the region.

The operation was meticulously planned and executed following credible intelligence inputs. On Sunday, the joint forces conducted a raid at Qamaruddin's residence, leading to the discovery of a Pakistan-made pistol and two Chinese grenades. The recovered consignment was intended to disrupt the electoral process in Poonch, which is on high alert due to the upcoming elections. The security forces emphasized the potential threat posed by the recovered weapons. The consignment, including the two Chinese grenades and the Pakistanmade pistol was smuggled in to create unrest during the elections. In a related development, security forces in Jammu and Kashmir carried out a separate operation in the Thannamandi area of Rajouri on April 14. This operation, conducted by SOG Rajouri and the 61 Rashtriya Rifles, led to the recovery of several rounds of arms and

ammunition. Items recovered included:

1 kg IED packet, seven half kg IED packets, two wireless sets, three AK-47 magazines, one ammunition pouch, 102 rounds of AK-47 ammunition, one charger. These seizures followed another successful operation on Saturday, where Jammu and Kashmir Police dismantled a terrorist hideout in the Arnas area. The hideout was found to contain a substantial quantity of arms and ammunition, including: Two detonators, 12 Assault Rifle cartridges, One pull-through, One hand-held tape recorder IED enabled, One calculator IED enabled, One battery, Various connecting wires. The arrest of Qamaruddin and the recovery of these weapons have heightened security concerns in the Poonch district and surrounding areas. The authorities are intensifying their efforts to ensure a peaceful electoral process. The presence of such sophisticated weaponry indicates the seriousness of the threat posed by militant elements attempting to destabilize the region. With the arrest of this OGW, security forces are continuing their search operations and investigations to uncover any further threats. They have urged the public to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activities to help maintain peace and security during the election period. The swift action by the joint forces in apprehending Qamaruddin and recovering dangerous weapons highlights the ongoing challenges faced by security forces in Jammu and Kashmir. The successful operations underscore the commitment of the security agencies to safeguard the democratic process and ensure the safety of the citizens. As investigations continue, the focus remains on neutralizing any threats and maintaining stability in the region.

TERRORIST HIDEOUT BUSTED IN JAMMU AND KASHMIR, ARMS AND AMMUNITION RECOVERED

n a chilling display of terrorism on April 28, a 40-year-old Junior Assistant in the Social Welfare Department, Mohammad Razak, was brutally killed in a terror attack at Kunda Topa in the Shahdara Sharief area of Rajouri district during the night hours. The attack has sent shockwaves through the community and left his family and friends reeling in grief. Razak who is brother of a Territorial Army (TA) Jawan, Mohammad Tahir Choudhary was shot dead by two LeT-affiliated foreign terrorists who barged into his house. Tahir, who

The family of Razak is still grappling with the devastating loss. His mother, Resham Bi, who had already been traumatized by the loss of her husband, Mohammad Akhtar, 20 years ago. She is now left to mourn the loss of her second son. Akhtar was also killed by militants at the same location. Razak was appointed in the Social Welfare Department on compassionate grounds following his father's death. Razak's wife, Gulnaz Akhter, was inconsolable during the burial, leaving behind five young children, including three daughters and two sons, aged between 5 and 10. The family's grief is palpable and their pain is a stark reminder of the devastating impact of terrorism on innocent lives.

"I was yet to come out of the shock of my husband's killing but now they have snatched my son," Resham Bi lamented, urging the security forces to hunt down her son's killers. Gulnaz Akhter, Razak's wife, was inconsolable during the burial. Razak leaves behind five young children, including three daughters and two sons, aged between 5 and 10.

The terrorists involved in the attack are two LeT-affiliated foreign terrorists, including the notorious Abu Hamza. In order to eliminate them, Jammu and Kashmir Police has announced a reward of Rs 10 lakh for information leading to the capture of Abu Hamza, who is believed to be hiding in the Shahdara Sharief and Dera Ki Gali areas. The attack has prompted heightened security measures throughout the area. The nefarious role of terrorists in the region is well-documented. They have been responsible for numerous terrorist incidents, including terror attacks, radicalization, recruitment, and terror financing. TERRORISM'S GRIM SHADOW; VDC GUARD KILLED IN FIERCE GUN BATTLE WITH TERRORISTS

n the serene valleys of Jammu and Kashmir, a dark cloud looms over the landscape as terrorism rears its ugly head once again, shattering the fragile peace that the residents strive to maintain. The recent tragic loss of innocent life in a deadly encounter with infiltrated terrorists serves as a poignant reminder of the relentless threat that looms over the region. In devastating turn of events, a Village Defence Guard (VDG) member has fallen victim to the scourge of terrorism in Jammu and Kashmir's Udhampur district. BRAVEHEART SOLDIER LOSES LIFE IN A DEADLY AMBUSH ON INDIAN AIR FORCE CONVOY IN POONCH

n May 4, a deadly attack on an Indian Air Force (IAF) convoy in Poonch District, Jammu and Kashmir, resulted in the death of one brave soldier and injuries to four other warriors. The convoy was ambushed by heavily armed terrorists at Bakrabal Mohalla near Sanai in Surankote Tehsil, marking the first major incident in the Jammu region this year. The attack targeted a group of five IAF personnel who were traveling through the area. The ambush, executed by terrorists, resulted in a fierce exchange of gunfire. Despite the rapid response and evacuation of the wounded to a nearby military hospital, one brave heart soldier, Corporal Vikky Pahade, succumbed to his injuries. The remaining four personnel sustained injuries of varying severity and were promptly treated.

In the aftermath of attack, security forces launched an extensive search operation in the region with a goal to track down these terrorists responsible for the ambush. Several suspected individuals were detained for questioning to gather intelligence on the assailants and their possible hideouts. TERROR STRIKES PAHALGAM: JAIPUR TOURISTS INJURED IN VICIOUS ATTACK, TERRORISTS CAPTURED

n May 18, 2024, a tourist couple from Jaipur, Rajasthan, was grievously injured in a terrorist attack in the Yannar area of the Pahalgam tourist resort, located in the Anantnag District of Jammu and Kashmir (J&K). The couple namely innocent Farah Khan and Tabrez Khan, were among a group of 50 holidayers from Jaipur who had ventured to the picturesque Valley for leisure and relaxation. The attack transpired shortly after the couple had disembarked from their van at the resort. In a sudden and unprovoked act of violence, terrorists opened fire on them from a distance of approximately 15-20 feet. This brutal assault resulted in Farah sustaining a gunshot wound to her shoulder, while Tabrez narrowly escaped fatal injury. A bullet grazed his nose, causing significant trauma to his eyes.

In an impressive display of efficiency and resolve, security forces in Anantnag swiftly apprehended two hybrid terrorists in connection with the attack. The arrested individuals, Waseem Ahmad Shah and Adnan Ahmad Beigh, are residents of Anantnag. They were found in possession of a pistol with a loaded magazine, a grenade and 120 AK-47 rounds. This rapid response underscored the security forces' commitment to maintaining peace and thwarting terrorist activities in the region. The government of Rajasthan responded promptly to the crisis. Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma announced financial assistance of Rs1 lakh each for Farah and Tabrez from the Chief



Minister's Relief Fund. In his statement, the Chief Minister vehemently condemned the terrorist attack and assured the injured couple of comprehensive support, including medical assistance and any other necessary aid to ensure their full recovery.

The resolute actions of the security forces in capturing the assailants have sent a powerful message against terrorism. Their success in solving the Pahalgam terror attack highlights a zero-tolerance stance towards such acts of violence. This operation forms part of a broader strategy aimed at eradicating the terror ecosystem in Kashmir and restoring peace and normalcy to the Valley.
